

CHILD-PARENT-RELATIONSHIP (C-P-R) TRAINING
Esteem-Building Responses Answersheet - Session 7

EXAMPLES:

Situation: Ali places the stethoscope on his father's heart.

Response: "*You know just how to use that!*"

Situation: Lauren tells you that the rope is a snake.

Response: "*You decided that's a snake.*"

Situation: Marcus carefully stacks the blocks up high.

Response: "*You're working hard to get those stacked all the way up to there.*"

Situation: Meera begins to gather crayons, paper, scissors, and glue.

Response: "*Looks like you have a plan for what you want to do next.*"

1. **Situation:** Your child struggles to get the cap off of the marker.

Response: "*You're determined to get that off.*"

2. **Situation:** Your child successfully pulls the cap off of the marker.

Response: "*You did it!*"

3. **Situation:** Your child says, "I know what this is; it's a pizza thing!" (you're not sure what the child means)

Response: "*You know what that's for.*" or "*You decided that's for pizza.*"

4. **Situation:** Your child asks what you want him to make with the playdough.

Response: "*That's something you can decide.*"

5. **Situation:** After completing a picture, your child looks at you and smiles.

Response: "*You made that just the way you wanted!*"
